ORDER

ALISON J. NATHAN, District Judge:

On August 1, 2017, the Plaintiffs filed a motion for conditional certification of a FLSA collective action and for court-approved distribution of notice. Dkt. No. 34. In a concurrently filed Memorandum Opinion and Order under temporary seal, the Court GRANTS the Plaintiff's motion.

In light of the parties' claims that some of the record before the Court consists of confidential information that should not be filed on the public docket, the Court has given the parties ten (10) days to propose any redactions to the Court's Memorandum Opinion and Order and to justify those redactions by reference to the Second Circuit's decision in *Lugosch v. Pyramid Co. of Onondaga*, 435 F.3d 110 (2d Cir. 2006). After determining which, if any, portions of the Memorandum Opinion and Order should be redacted, the Court will file the Memorandum Opinion and Order on the public docket.
